Surgical Technology Program

Advanced Placement / Transfer Credit / Credit for Experience

Individuals who have previously completed a Surgical Technology certificate program may apply for admission to the associate degree program in order to complete the degree-level General Education Core Courses and Essential Technical Courses.

Applicants must submit transcripts showing successful completion of a program accredited in Surgical Technology by the Commission on Accreditation of Allied Health Education Programs (CAAHEP), proof of current Certified Surgical Technologist (CST) certification, and proof of current employment as a surgical technologist or a surgical technology educator.

Individuals who completed a program before March 1, 2000 may submit a letter requesting special consideration if they provide proof of current CST and related employment.

A minimum of 25% of program requirements must be completed at Calhoun Community College in order to earn the Surgical Technology AAS Degree.

Transfer credit will only be considered for surgical technology courses completed within the previous 12 months at a CAAHEP-accredited program.

Students wishing to receive transfer credit must pass, with a 75% or higher, the CCC ST final didactic and skills exams for the courses that transfer credit is being considered.
